3 Classes of Non-Welded Demo Cars

ABSOLUTELY NO bolting, welding, or other form of reinforcing on cars except as listed in the rules and regulations.

Last three (3) cars running in each heat will be paid \$25 each. NO HEAT TROPHIES.

1. **1980 AND NEWER FULLSIZE CARS:** (no limos or hearse allowed) **FEATURE:** 1st \$600 • 2nd \$400 • 3rd \$300 • 4th \$200 • 5th \$100
2. **COMPACT CARS:** (107" wheelbase or less, 4 cylinder or 6 cylinder motors only) **FEATURE:** 1st \$400 & Trophy • 2nd \$300 & Trophy • 3rd \$175
3. **1970 and Newer 2 WHEEL DRIVE HALF TON PICKUPS:** (no 4x4 or ¾ ton conversions – only 2 wheel drive 1/2 ton pickups only) **FEATURE:** 1st \$400 & Trophy • 2nd \$300 & Trophy • 3rd \$175
4. **GRAND SLAM:** (any compact car or full size car running after the feature) 1st \$300 & Trophy • 2nd \$200 & Trophy • 3rd \$125

RULES AND REGULATIONS – In the interest and safety to all, the following rules shall apply:

1. If a driver or person is under the age of 18, they must have a waiver of liability signed by parent or legal guardian. No one under the age of 14 is allowed in the pits. NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. Drivers must be 16 years of age and have a picture ID at registration.
3. All drivers and pit persons must pay \$25 pit entry fee and sign waiver of liability.
4. All drivers must attend the drivers meeting.
5. No hitting of drivers door.
6. The decision of the head flag person and other flag persons are final (we will refer to them as the judges). Only the driver will be allowed to approach the head flag person with a disagreement as a safe time.
7. Drivers must remain in your vehicle at all times, with protective gear on, and hands and arms inside with seatbelt on at all times unless flag persons or safety personally ok you to exit your vehicle.
8. Each driver will be allowed one red flag. The head flag person and safety personnel will have final say.
9. A one (1) minute time limit will be in effect. If the driver does not hit another car within this time limit, they shall be disqualified. The judges will decide if the driver has been sitting too long and may disqualify the car.
10. Green means go – Red means stop – Black means disqualified
11. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or controlled substances will be permitted in the pits by anyone in the pit area. Anyone found in the pit area violating this policy will result in your team being disqualified and will forfeit all fees paid.
12. All cars are to be removed from the fairgrounds immediately after the demo.
13. All judges' rulings are final. Your participation in the event may be terminated and/or entry fees and prize monies forfeited at the judges' discretion.
14. Anyone violating the rules will be disqualified and will forfeit fees paid.

GENERAL SAFETY AND VEHICLE REGULATIONS

1. SEATBELTS, HELMET, AND SAFETY

- a. Functioning safety belts are required. They must be run under the chassis of the car through two (2) holes punched in the floor boards behind the driver's seat.
- b. All drivers must wear an approved safety helmet and eye protection. If you do not have one, borrow one from another driver that is not in your heat.
- c. Drivers will wear long-sleeve shirt/jacket, long pants, and shoes. No shorts, cut-offs, or open-toed shoes.

2. WELDING

- a. Drivers door may be welded shut with three (3) 6' x 1" strips. All other doors must be chained or bolted shut. Drivers door must also be reinforced with some type of bar or pipe. Also up to 3" pipe can be placed behind the drivers seat from door post to door post.
- b. Hoods can be chained or bolted using no more than 6 (six) bolts, short chains, or redi-rod. Maximum diameter of 1 inch. Redi-rod may be welded to the top of the frame or drilled through and bolted. No extra welding. Folding of hood is allowed. Trunks may be chained or bolted using no more than 6 (six) bolts or short chains.
- c. One windshield bar is recommended from the roof to the door by welding or bolting not more than 3 inches in diameter and not exceed more than 6 inches either way. d. No other welding, internally or externally, will be allowed. No welding of shocks.
- e. Protective lenses or face shields are required when cutting, welding, or grinding in the pit area.

3. GLASS/TIRES

- a. All glass, including headlights and taillights, must be removed.
- b. Standard tires only – no implement tires allowed.

4. DOOR SECURITY

- a. Driver's door can be welded with 6" strip as stated.
- b. All doors are to be chained or bolted to assure they stay closed.
- c. Roll-over bars are allowed, but not required.
- d. 16" hole to be cut in the hood for fire suppression.

5. FUEL TANK, BATTERY, COOLING SYSTEM, INTERIOR, REMOVAL/RELOCATION

- a. Battery must be in altered position and must be covered and anchored securely.
- b. Factory gas tank must be removed. Gas tank used in derby car must be secured properly in back seat or in box with absolutely no movement. A maximum of five (5) gallons of gas will be allowed.
- c. Transmission coolers are permitted, but must have all lines covered.
- d. Transmission oil cooler or radiation may not be relocated, but may be removed.
- e. Electric fuel pumps are permitted if safely placed and a shut-off is accessible and properly marked. f. All air bags must be removed.
- g. Carpet, rear seat, external chrome moldings, and headliner must be removed from vehicle.

6. ENGINES, BUMPERS, and SUSPENSION

- a. Engines and bumpers are to remain stock to vehicle and year. No special bumper may be used. No trailer hitches or any types of reinforcement, front or rear, may be used. No added weights, lifts or chains allowed.
- b. Engine and Tranny from any manufacturer to remain as close to factory as possible.
- c. Suspension to remain factory (ie. No changing coil-over rear for leaf spring)
- d. No Leaf spring clamps allowed on cars or pickups.

7. ADVERTISING AND NUMBERS

- a. NUMBERS MUST BE PAINTED ON BOTH FRONT 2 DOORS AND ON THE ROOF. Numbers must be 18" high on the doors, and 36" high on the roof. Last name of the driver must also be painted on the car in large letters.
- b. If there is a duplication of numbers, the judges reserve the right to change numbers.
- c. No profanity on the car. You may be asked to paint over it at judges' request.

8. OTHER

- a. If you think it might be illegal, or question if it may be, then don't do it.
- b. COMPACT CARS: It is highly recommended to install a pipe, 3" max behind the drivers seat from door post to door post. You may also install a pipe under the steering column from door post to door post.
- c. 2 WHEEL DRIVE HALF-TON PICKUPS: Tailgate must be chained or bolted – no welding. No hitches or custom bumpers. Boxes should be bolted to the cab. Rubber substance/cushion must be placed between the cab and the box. Boxes must be cleared of all debris. It is highly recommended to install a bar behind the drivers seat, 3" max.
